

Public/Family Skating

Program Information

- 1. During Public and Family Skates, there are no hockey sticks, pucks, balls, chairs or strollers permitted.
- 2. Skating aids that are designed specifically for ice are only permitted during Family Skates.
- 3. For the Family Skate, admission requires patrons under 17 to be accompanied by at least one adult. Adults who are unable to participate are asked to speak with Customer Service Kiosk Staff regarding accommodations.
- 4. Please use the dressing rooms or the players' bench to rest. Please do not sit on the boards.
- 5. Playing tag of any kind is NOT permitted.
- 6. Everyone must skate in one direction, backwards skating is not permitted.
- 7. Any disruptive behaviour or horseplay such as play fighting, snowballs or deliberate interference to another skater will result in removal from the facility.
- 8. No food or drinks are permitted on the ice. Water only please.
- 9. Public/Family Skating is for leisure skating and not for hockey drills or figure skating practice.
- 10. Please respect your facility.

CSA approved helmets are highly recommended for all ice programs.

When the buzzer sounds/Zamboni doors open, all patrons must leave the ice immediately. Skate Cruisers are present to ensure the public/family skating is an enjoyable experience for all. The skate cruisers will enforce these rules and have the authority from the municipality to have person(s) not abiding by these rules removed from the facility.
