

Shinny & Family Shinny Program Information

- 1. Check-In for the program will begin 30 minutes prior to the program start at the Customer Service Kiosk. All participants must be present at time of check-in and spots will not be held for participants who are not present.
- 2. Payment must be made prior to going on the ice surface. All participants are required to wear a wristband which will be checked upon entry. Participants who prefer to put on their wristband themselves are asked to advise the Customer Service Associate and to please do so in front of them.
- 3. All participants must wear a CSA approved helmet. Full equipment must be worn. Players 17 years and under also require a mouth guard, neck guard and full face protection.
- 4. For Family Shinny, there must be one adult over the age of 18 on the ice surface for every 4 participants under the age of 18.
- 5. Organized hockey drills and use of pylons is prohibited. Please share the ice fairly, no slap shots. This is a non-contact program. Players who engage in rough or dangerous play will be asked to leave the program.
- 6. Shinny schedules are based on year of birth. Players must participate in the appropriate category. Exceptions will not be made.
- 7. Parents are not permitted on the bench during shinny times.
- 8. No food or drinks are permitted on the ice. Water only.
- 9. Please respect your facility.
- 10. The shinny program is limited to 20 participants plus 4 goalies on any time. Family Shinny is limited to 30 players on the Olympic rink and 20 players on the NHL rinks.
