### **Fraud Prevention and Awareness Presentation for Seniors (Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre)**

In this presentation we will talk about who the CAFC is, provide some stats, How victims are being contacted, the top 10 frauds that effect seniors, how to report and what to do if you have become a victim.
