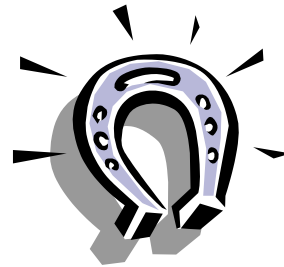


# TRADITIONAL RHYMES AND SONGS
