BYLAW NUMBER 1994-79

A BYLAW AMEND BYLAW 1987-85 (A BYLAW TO REGULATE SMOKING IN PLACES OF PUBLIC ASSEMBLY [BINGO PARLOURS])

BE IT ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Newmarket as follows:

1. THAT Bylaw 1987-85 be amended by adding to Section 1 (3), after the word "admitted" the words "such as a bingo parlour,".

2. THAT Bylaw 1987-85 be amended by adding thereto the following:

THEATRES AND PLACES OF PUBLIC ASSEMBLY (BINGO PARLOURS)

10. (3) Except as provided in Subsection (4), no person shall smoke in any part of an enclosed indoor area being used as a place of public assembly;


(4) Subject to The Fire Marshals Act, for the purpose of Subsection (3):

(a) the proprietor may designate an area of not more than 80% of the floor area for the purpose of smoking and such area shall bear a sign or signs marked "Smoking In This Area Only".

3. THAT Bylaw 1987-85 be amended by adding to Section 11 (1), after the word "theatre", the words "or place of public assembly".
