BYLAW 1994-41

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF PUBLIC PARKS IN THE TOWN OF NEWMARKET.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to pass a bylaw regulating the use of public parks in the Town of Newmarket;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Newmarket as follows:

1(a). GROUP ACTIVITIES-GENERAL

No person shall make use of any park or recreational centre in the Town of Newmarket for the purpose of holding a meeting, concert, sing song, sit in, dancing or any other group activity unless the person or persons responsible for organizing such activity has obtained a permit in the form prescribed in Schedule "A" from the Newmarket Parks and Recreation Department.

1(b). ORGANIZED SPORTS ACTIVITIES

No person shall engage in any organized sport or game or athletic contest conducted in any park or recreational facility in the Town of Newmarket unless the person or persons responsible for organizing such activity has obtained a permit in the form prescribed in Schedule "A" from the Newmarket Parks and Recreation Department.

2. FAILURE TO SURRENDER USE OF A FACILITY

Any person who makes use of a park or recreational facility without a permit shall upon request surrender the use of the facility to any person or persons who have obtained a permit for the use of the facility.

3.(a) HOURS PARKS NOT OPEN TO PUBLIC

No person shall linger or remain in any public park or recreational centre owned by the Town of Newmarket on any day between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.

3.(b) EXCEPTION

Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 3(a), where a permit has been issued by the Town of Newmarket Recreation Department in the form prescribed from time to time, it shall be lawful for persons engaged in the activity for which the permit has been issued to remain in the park or recreational centre until such time as set out in such permit.

4. PERMITS

Permits for the use of any park or recreational facility may be issued by the Commissioner of Parks and Recreation or such person as may be designated by the Commissioner of Parks and Recreation from time to time for such purposes.


5. PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES-GENERAL

- 5.(a) No person shall defecate or urinate in any public park in the Town of Newmarket except in a structure provided for that purpose.
 - 5.(b) No person shall use any park equipment or park facilities except for those purposes for which such park equipment and/or facilities have been designed.
 - 5.(c) No person shall operate any motorized vehicle within any public park except within any designated parking area.
 - 5.(d) No person shall operate any unlicensed motorized vehicle at any time in any part of a park.
 - 5.(e) No person shall drive or operate a motorized snow vehicle in any public park in the Town of Newmarket.
 - 5.(f) No person shall operate any remote, wire or radio controlled aircraft within any public park except in accordance with the terms of a permit issued by the Newmarket Parks and Recreation Department in the form set out in Schedule "B" hereto.
6. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided for under the Provincial Offences Act.


7. Bylaws numbered 1991-157 and 1975-60 are hereby repealed.
