SCHEDULE 14

TO LICENSE, REGULATE AND GOVERN THE OWNERS OR OPERATORS OF PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEMS, SOUND EQUIPMENT LOUD SPEAKERS OR SIMILAR DEVICES, WHEN USED ON A HIGHWAY, PUBLIC LANDS OR LANDS ADJACENT THERETO, OR WHEN EMITTING SOUND THERETO.

**DEFINITIONS**

14.1 In this By-law

- a) **“public address system”** means a system using microphones and loud-speakers to enable groups of people to hear clearly.
- b) **“Town Clerk”** means the Clerk of the Town of Newmarket or his/her designate.
- c) **“Town”** means the Town of Newmarket in the Regional Municipality of York.

14.2 No one shall operate a public address system, sound equipment, loud speakers or similar devices on the highways, public lands or lands adjacent thereto, or when emitting sound thereto, in the Town without a license so to do.

14.3 The fee as per Schedule ‘A’.

14.4 No public address system, sound equipment, loud speakers or similar device as set out in 15.1 shall be used for the following purposes.

- a) advertising wares or merchandise
- b) sale of wares or merchandise
- c) conducting campaigns for election to any public office

14.5 Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting Presiding Justice, a penalty not exceeding the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$305.00 includes costs), for each offence, and every such penalty shall be recoverable under the *The Summary Convictions Act*, as amended.
