SCHEDULE 6

TO LICENSE, REGULATE AND GOVERN PERSONS WHO FOR HIRE OR GAIN, KEEP BILLIARD, POOL OR BAGATELLE TABLES.

**DEFINITIONS**

- 6.1 In this By-law – Schedule 6
- a) **“Billiard Hall”** means a premises or part thereof upon which is kept for hire, amusement, gain or profit one or more billiard tables;
  - b) **“Billiard Table”** includes a pool table, table soccer, table hockey or games with similar meaning.
  - c) **“Town Clerk”** means the Clerk of the Town of Newmarket or his/her designate.
  - d) **“Town”** means the Town of Newmarket in the Regional Municipality of York.
- 6.2 That no person, persons, corporate or proprietary club shall within the corporate limits of the Town directly or indirectly keep or have in their possession or on their premises any billiard, pool or bagatelle table or keep or have any such table, whether used or not, without first obtaining from the Town Clerk of the Town a license.
- 6.3 The amount payable as per Schedule ‘A’.
- 6.4 The licensee herein referred to shall keep the premises referred to in the license in a clean and tidy condition, and no profane or obscene language shall be allowed to be used in any place licensed under the provisions of this By-law.
- 6.5 Any license issued pursuant to the provisions of this By-law may be revoked by and upon the resolution of Council.
- 6.6 Every person who contravenes a provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine not exceeding three hundred dollars (\$305.00 includes costs).
