SCHEDULE 8

TO LICENSE AND REGULATE BOWLING ALLEYS

DEFINITIONS

- 8.1 In this By-law – Schedule 8
- a) **“bowling alley”** means a long narrow wooden lane and a building that houses such lanes.
 - b) **“Town Clerk”** means the Clerk of the Town of Newmarket or his/her designate.
 - c) **“Town”** means the Town of Newmarket in the Regional Municipality of York.
- 8.2 No person, persons or corporation shall keep for hire any bowling alley within the corporate limits of the Town without first obtaining from the Town Clerk of the Town a license therefore and paying to the Town the fee as hereinafter set out.
- 8.3 The appropriate fee as set out in Schedule ‘A’.
- 8.4 All bowling alleys and lobbies and surrounding areas shall at all times be kept and maintained in a neat and tidy condition and no profane or obscene language shall be allowed to be used in any place licensed under the provisions of this By-law.
- 8.5 Any license issued pursuant to the provisions of this By-law may be revoked by resolution of Council.
- 8.6 Every person who contravenes a provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine not exceeding three hundred dollars (\$305.00 includes costs).
