



Private Property Tree Removal Application Form

Residential Application for Trees causing Property Damage

Application instructions

Application Number: _____

1. This is not a permit. Removal of one (1) or more trees each with a diameter greater than 20 centimeters before receiving an approved permit will put you in contravention of By-law #2022-10.
2. Ensure you have read and understand the Private Tree Protection By-law in its entirety before completing this application
3. This application is applicable to the injury or destruction of any one (1) or more trees having a tree diameter of twenty (20) centimetres or more measured at 1.4 meters, or any multi-stemmed tree(s) having a combined base diameter of twenty (20) centimetres, unless authorized by permit to do so pursuant to By-law 2022-10.
4. Application form to be completed by applicant. Print CLEARLY.
5. Typical processing time for applications is a maximum of 30 working days from the submission of a complete Application. The length of time to process the application may be impacted if additional information is required, multiple trees are being reviewed or the Private Property Tree Removal Application is to be reviewed in conjunction with other development applications. Incomplete applications will not be processed resulting in delays and will restart the process initiation time. Municipal address must include street name and number. (911 numbers for rural location)
6. Provide two copies of digitally produced plans or drawings of the property showing locations of all trees, including trees(s) to be removed and tree(s) being preserved.
7. Provide a minimum of two colour photographs of each tree(s) being removed. Photos are to include a close-up and a photo taken at a distance providing a complete view of the tree.
8. An Arborist Report must be completed by an ISA or MTCU certified Arborist. This report is to include the following:
 9. Percentage of total property canopy cover being removed
 10. Species of tree(s) being removed
 11. Diameter size of the tree(s), in centimeters,
 12. measured at the base of the tree and at 1.4 meters.
 13. Health/Condition of trees being removed
 14. Reason for removal, including a signed declaration outlining the tree is removed for construction or non-construction purposes.
 15. Replacement recommendations to remove dead, dying or hazardous tree(s)
 16. Arborist certification number
 17. A certificate by a Professional Engineer and/or Building Inspector must be submitted indicating that the tree(s) will in the near future cause structural damage that cannot be mitigated other than by cutting or removing the protected tree.
18. A review fee of \$100 per tree will apply for each tree removed.



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19. Provide two copies of a replanting plan or landscape plan, if replanting is proposed. All tree removals which are not for dead, dying or hazardous trees will require replanting. Replanting is required to be privately completed within 12 months of permit date.
20. The number of trees to be replanted is calculated by a one to one replacement for trees removed.
21. Once the tree(s) are replanted the applicant is required to contact the Town for a final inspection.
22. If applicant does not wish to re-plant the required replacement trees, they may opt to pay for trees to be planted on Town lands within the community. A fee for each replacement tree required will be added to the permit cost. Fees collected for trees are to be used for tree planting through Town funded programs.
23. If paying by cheque, make cheque payable to: Corporation of the Town of Newmarket
24. Provide written consent from an adjacent property owner where the base of a tree straddles a property line or is beyond the applicant owners' lands.
25. Provide written authorization from the owner if this application is signed by an applicant other than the owner, or by an agent.

A site plan or drawing of the subject property is required and must include the following information:

- The location of the tree(s) you wish to injure or remove and the distance of the trees to the property lines and/or buildings.
- The location of any buildings on the property. Proposed and current building locations are required.
- The dimensions of the property and location of the streets.
- The location and size of trees being protected.
- The proposed location for replacement tree(s).
- Other natural features on the property such as slopes and creeks.



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This information must be supported by an Arborist Report completed by an ISA or MTCU certified arborist, a certification of property damage by a Professional Engineer and/or Building Inspector, and approved by the Forestry Supervisor, Parks and Property Services Department.
