Palmerston Heritage Railway Museum: Visit the Palmerston Heritage Railway Museum and enjoy a presentation about Palmerston as a working railway centre with a roundhouse, coaling tower, freight sheds, and cattle pens. You may also visit a restored station with its own history and even ride on a mock steam train if you would like. Please note there are a number of steps at this attraction.

Lunch: Lunch will be at the museum pavilion, unless rain forces it into the community hall. The buffet menu includes salad, lasagna, chicken, vegetables, and dessert.

Drayton Festival Theatre: After lunch, head to the Drayton Festival Theatre for a matinee of *The New Canadian Curling Club*. This brand-new play is laugh-out-loud funny and quietly moving, as it combines immigration, community, and national identity, resulting in an inspiring and hilarious story of a group of unlikely athletes who face off against local prejudice and claim their identity as "new Canadians". Don't miss the hit comedy about burning rocks, bonspiel beers, and becoming a team. Contains some language and mature themes.

West Montrose Covered Bridge: Visit the famous West Montrose Covered Bridge. The "Kissing Bridge" is one of the oldest covered bridges in Canada and has been featured in films such as In *The Mouth of Madness* (1995) and *It* (2017).
