**Family Stick & Puck** - A time to have fun with friends & family and pass the puck around. Each "group" must have a minimum of one child and one guardian (18+) to a maximum of six patrons per group. CSA approved helmet is mandatory. Participants under 18 years also require full face protection. Hockey gloves are recommended. No Slap Shots. Please share the ice fairly.

**Shinny** - A recreational time that often results in a game of pick up hockey. Pay at kiosk BEFORE time begins. Full equipment required. Players 17 years and under also require a mouth guard, neck guard and full face protection. All participants must play within their age group.

**Parent & Tot Shinny** - For parents to teach their child (six and under) the basics of skating with a puck. Admission covers one adult and one child. Additional children may be paid for separately. Max. ratio of 1 adult to 3 children. CSA approved helmet and gloves are required.

CSA approved helmets are mandatory for all shinny ice programs. Refer to program details for more information. This schedule is subject to change without notice. Payment is required BEFORE you may participate in each program. All participants must be present at time of payment. Check in begins half an hour before program start time.
