

# Family Stick & Puck

## Program Information

1. Check-In for the program will begin 30 minutes prior to the program start at the Customer Service Kiosk. All participants must be present at time of check-in and spots will not be held for participants who are not present.
2. Payment must be made prior to going on the ice surface. All participants are required to wear a wristband which will be checked upon entry. Participants who prefer to put on their wristband themselves are asked to advise the Customer Service Associate and to please do so in front of them.
3. There should be one adult on the ice surface for each group (up to 6 people total). Each group will be charged \$9 per visit. Adults who are unable to participate are asked to speak with Customer Service Kiosk Staff regarding accommodations.
4. All participants must wear a CSA approved helmet. Players 17 years and under also require full face protection. Hockey gloves are highly recommended.
5. Organized hockey drills and use of pylons is prohibited.
6. Please share the ice fairly, no slap shots. This is a non-contact program.
7. No food or drinks are permitted on the ice. Water only please.
8. Please respect your facility.

Please note, this program is very popular and spacing is limited to maintain the quality of the program. Family Stick & Puck is limited to 20 participants when held on an NHL sized rink and 30 participants when held on the Olympic rink.
