COMMENTS

The purpose of this information report is to advise Members of Council that the Town has received a noise exemption request from the Region of York, regarding the work to take place on Bayview Avenue at the Region of York's Sewage Pumping Station. The request is for an exemption from the Noise By-law 2004-94 for December 20th and 21st from 10:30 pm to 6:30 am for emergency sewage repair work at 360 Bayview Parkway.

Regional Municipality of York is requesting to undertake the work at non-peak hours (10:30 p.m. through 6:30 a.m.) starting tonight.

Noise exemptions are normally granted by Council; however, due to the time sensitivity and in the absence of a scheduled Council meeting, staff will be approving the request in accordance with past practices. In accordance with the Procedure Bylaw any Members of Council may request an Information Report to be placed on an upcoming Committee of the Whole agenda for discussion.
