

## **Newmarket's Old Town Hall receives federal funding for state-of-the-art technology**

**Town thanks Government of Canada for generous investment**

**NEWMARKET, Ontario, September 15** – Earlier this week, the Member of Parliament for Newmarket-Aurora Kyle Peterson visited the Town of Newmarket's newly renovated Old Town Hall and announced that the [Government of Canada](#), through the [Department of Canadian Heritage](#), will provide more than \$80,000 to equip the space with the latest in audio-visual technology.

"Our investment in the audio-visual equipment for the newly renovated Old Town Hall is a significant contribution to our community's culture and heritage," said MP Peterson. "I am confident that the residents of our community will continue to value and enjoy the wonderful rich heritage of the Old Town Hall for generations to come."

The funding – available under the [Canada Cultural Spaces Fund Program](#) – allows for the installation of LED lighting fixtures, dimmers and relays, LCD monitors, wireless microphones, a portable programmable display and a digital mixer.

Once the Old Town Hall officially opens its doors to the public on **September 22**, the state-of-the-art technology will allow for stronger, more dynamic performances from those who use the historic, multi-purpose building for the performing arts.

According to Mayor Van Bynen, the Government of Canada's investment helps to solidify the building's reputation as the cultural hub of the Town.

"On behalf of the Town of Newmarket and our Council, I would like to thank our federal government for its generous investment in our community," said Mayor Van Bynen. "This funding will go a long way in providing our local artists, creative performers and their audiences with an experience that's well beyond the ordinary."
